RHB Debit Card (Conventional)	Inclusion of additional item under clause 7.6	<p>Any costs or charges due from the Cardmember will be debited from the Account and reflected in the Statement. Any costs or charges paid by the Cardmember will not be refundable under any circumstances unless there is a manifest error due to the act, omission, default, negligence and/or misconduct on the part of RHB Bank and/or any of its employees, representatives and agents.</p> <p>RHB MULTI CURRENCY VISA DEBIT CARD/RHB PREMIER MULTI CURRENCY VISA DEBIT CARD Any fees & charges charged will be deducted from the RHB Ringgit Malaysia Account directly.</p> <p>Refunds for any overseas or local transactions will be credited to either the RHB Multi Currency Account or the RHB Ringgit Malaysia Account, based on the currency used for the transaction.</p>
RHB Debit Card-i (Islamic)	Inclusion of additional item under clause 7.6	<p>Any costs or charges due from the Cardholder shall be debited to the Account and reflected in the Account statement. Any costs or charges paid by the Cardholder will not be refundable under any circumstances unless there is a manifest error due to the act, omission, default, negligence and/or misconduct on the part of RHB Islamic Bank and/or any of its employees, representatives and agents.</p> <p><u>RHB MULTI CURRENCY VISA DEBIT CARD-i / RHB PREMIER MULTI CURRENCY VISA DEBIT CARD-i</u> Any fees & charges charged will be deducted from the RHB Ringgit Malaysia Account directly.</p> <p>Refunds for any overseas or local transactions will be credited to either the RHB Multi Currency Account-i or the RHB Ringgit Malaysia Account-i, based on the currency used for the transaction.</p>
