FIRST EVER RHB WCE CENTURY RIDE ATTRACTS OVER 3,000 CYCLISTS FROM AROUND THE WORLD

Sitiawan, Perak – The RHB Banking Group ("RHB" or the "Group"), in partnership with the West Coast Expressway Sdn. Bhd. ("WCE"), today concluded its inaugural RHB WCE Century Ride, Malaysia's first closed highway century ride, on a high note. Over 3,000 cyclists from across the country and the globe, some from as far as Argentina, rode towards the finishing line after traversing one of the nation's scenic cycling routes on a closed highway.

The event was flagged off by YBhg. Datuk Seri Hj. Hasnol Zam Zam Bin Hj. Ahmad, Chief Secretary, Ministry of Works Malaysia, at the starting line at the Lekir Toll Plaza, Perak, at 6:45 AM, setting off an electrifying atmosphere as cyclists jostled to get ahead of their fellow riders. The inaugural RHB WCE Century Ride, held in conjunction with Visit Perak Year 2024, offered four routes of 160 km, 90 km, 28 km, and 14 km along the West Coast Expressway E32 to cyclists of different fitness levels.

The RHB WCE Century Ride 2024 aimed to promote cycling tourism in Perak and showcase the scenic beauty of the West Coast Expressway alignment. One of the event's highlights was the vibrant carnival atmosphere, providing activities and entertainment for attendees of all backgrounds.
